

## General ideas on 2021 Synthesis Report

- Concise publication on progress towards achieving the SFM by the end of 2020 since 1990s (reference years: 1990, 2000, 2005, 2010, 2015 and 2020)
- ➤ A clear document about importance and role of Montreal Process, regional forests and forestry for the world.
- ➤ A visionary, forward-looking document that would help shape policy making.
- ➤ Written in plain language that engages non-experts, including policy-makers, legislators and the interested public so that well understanding of the importance of SFM and better promotion of forest management using C&I.

## Reporting format

- Description of the general status and progress of MP C&I, forest resources and its protection & development in Montreal Process regions, one or two paragraph by each indicators.
- ➤ Diagram and chart for different-terms figures and comparison in the world.
- > Special columns: typical cases since 1990s for some indicators, such as large-scale afforestation/reforestation, green industry of wood/non-wood products, employment, forest recreation & tourism, forest certification and forestry carbon trading etc.

Requirements of countries' duty for provision of relevant cases documents from TAC.

## Available data source

- ➤ Global and national statistics of FRA2020: most figures on forests.
- > FAO statistics database on annual volume and value of wood products.
- ➤ National Communications, national GHG Inventory (UNFCCC):

  national figures on GHG from AFLOU or LULUCF (annual or two-year update).
- > FSC/PEFC/National standard: area of forest certification.

## Reporting indicators

- Covering: key indicators of 7 criteria including forest resources and its ecological, economical and social functions/profits/values, and institution, legislation etc.
- > Suggested supplement
  - 2. b Growing stock of forest: 2a (FRA2020).
  - 5. a Carbon stock of biomass components: above/below ground.
- 6.1.a Value and volume of wood products: roundwood removals (FAO statistics).
  - 6.1.b Non-wood forest products removals: 7c (FRA2020).
  - 6.1.c Revenue from forest-based environmental services.
