Two Main Reporting Objectives



1. Forest conditions in member countries and their implications for forest sustainability
 - E.g., Forest area, disturbance, biodiversity conservation, rural poverty, etc.
2. Country experience in using MPC&I and related sustainability reporting
 - E.g., Applicability of MPC&I, challenges, novel approaches, sufficiency for assessment and management needs

Two Main Sections/Strategies



1. Cross – country reporting and comparison
2. Country – specific reporting

(Bald Eagle near Mendenhall Glacier SE Alaska)

Cross – country reporting and comparison

- 10 indicators reported for each country (where possible) on same charts and tables for easy comparison (is this a good idea?)
- Summary narratives to compare and contrast key findings on:
 - Sustainability conditions; experience in applying C&I, reporting status, etc.



(Urban Forest in Portland Oregon)

Country – specific reporting



Brief country – specific sections on:

- Narrative on forest conditions and sustainability (with some data if needed, though no thorough integration with other countrys' data)
- Status of MP reporting
- Successes and challenges in applying the MPC&I
- Other observations

(countries should be free to say what they want here, though Egnlish editing would be good)

(Forest Fire in California)

Possible Organization of Report



1. Executive Summary (key findings and observations mainly from chapter 3)
2. 10 indicator data chapter
3. Cross country comparison of findings (narrative, maybe with some charts, integrating chapters 2 & 4)
4. Country-specific reports

(Outside Jasper, Canada)

Overarching themes to consider



- About forest conditions
 - Forest conditions, threats and bright spots
 - Dynamic change and Climate change
- About MP application
 - Flexibility (different country approaches)
 - Comprehensive (big picture)
 - Understandable (communication)
 - Integration with other processes
